PrEP treatment and monitoring

- Z79.899 On pre-exposure prophylaxis for HIV
- Z79.899 Encounter for long-term current use of medication

HIV Screening

- Z71.7 Encounter for HIV counseling
- Z11.4 Encounter for screening for HIV
- Z20.6 Contact with and (suspected) exposure to HIV
- Z20.9 Contact with or exposure to communicable disease
- Z91.89 At risk for HIV due to
 - Being caregiver of HIV-positive person
 - Due to bisexual contact
 - Due to heterosexual contact
 - Due to homosexual contact
 - Due to injection drugs
 - Due to occupational risk factor
 - Due to history of transfusion
 - Due to partner with HIV

HIV Test Results

- Z21 HIV test positive
- Z78.9 False positive HIV serology
- R75 Indeterminate HIV result

STI Screening

- Z11.3 STD screening
- Z20.2 Contact with and (suspected) exposure to infections with predominantly sexual mode of transmission

PrEP Coverage for Insured Patients

- Most private plans are required to cover prescription and related services without cost-sharing. Prior authorizations not allowed.
- Medi-Cal covers prescriptions, labs, medical visits. Include note to the pharmacy to “bill state carve-out and not the managed-care plan”.
- The [Gilead co-pay assistance program](#) provides co-pay assistance for F/TDF or F/TAF

- The [California PrEP Assistance Program \(PrEP-AP\)](#) helps low income [$\leq 500\%$ Federal Poverty Line (FPL)] insured patients pay for medical visits and labs not covered by plan, and assists with F/TDF or F/TAF co-pays after Gilead benefit is exhausted.
- Adults with confidentiality concerns can enroll in [California PrEP-AP program](#).
- Minors on parent’s plan with confidentiality concerns can sign up for [myhealthmyinfo.org](#) or use [PrEP-AP](#) or those with Medi-Cal, can use [Medi-Cal Minor Consent Program](#)
- Medicare beneficiaries
 - With prescription coverage and income $< 500\%$ FPL can enroll in [California PrEP-AP program](#) for co-pay assistance.
 - Without prescription coverage, can enroll in [Gilead Advancing Access](#) to receive free F/TDF or F/TAF.

PrEP Coverage for Uninsured Patients

- The Ending the HIV Epidemic: [Ready, Set, PrEP program](#) provides free monthly F/TDF or F/TAF for those without prescription coverage regardless of income.
- People with income $\leq 500\%$ FPL can enroll in [Gilead Advancing Access](#) and [California PrEP-AP program](#) to access free monthly F/TDF or F/TAF and related medical services (e.g. labs, visits, STI treatment).
- [Minors](#) can enroll in PrEP-AP
